JUNIOR EXHIBITOR PROGRAM UPDATE: TICA's Junior Exhibitors Program is open to anyone under the age of eighteen. As members of TICA, each Junior Exhibitor's continued success is gauged by their accomplishments and personal growth.

The program consists of six levels through which the youth may progress, with each level having different activities and testing questions. At the three junior levels, the emphasis is on learning about TICA, the etiquette and procedures of showing, and basic

cat health and welfare. At the three senior levels, the emphasis is on advanced knowledge of cat showing, cat breeds, working at a show, and TICA.

Juniors involved in the program learn to be responsible and ethical cat fanciers and caretakers, and productive members of TICA. Along the way, they can earn an Excellence in Individual Distinction such as:

- Excellence in Art, Graphic Design and Photography
- Excellence in Regional Administration (show reporters, regional websites or newsletters)
- **Excellence in Show Production and Administration**
- Excellence in Breeding
- Excellence in Science and Feline Health

The Junior Exhibitor program is currently being revamped to give Junior participants diverse opportunities to obtain an award of excellence (as noted above). Although not yet finalized and approved by the Board (expect that at the Winter Board meeting), the revamped program will encourage our young exhibitors to fully participate in the JE program.



Update on projects:

- 1. **Implement automated transfer of ownership –** We are in the final testing phase for this functionality and hope to have this announced and released by the board meeting.
- Implement automated litter registration for all other litters
 Much of the development work is done; we plan to be in final testing in early October.
- 3. Add Scoring Information to Cat Records to display scores. It will take about four weeks to get this into production.
- 4. **Self-Managed Breeder Listings** nearly done; this will allow members to submit extensions and change photos on active breeder listings—This will be demo'd at the annual meeting.
- **5.** Clerking and Show Application The ownership transfer of the TOES entry clerking and show app over to TICA is progressing. We will have an update at the annual board meeting.
- 6. **Improve TFMS Messaging –** Roeann Fulkerson is working with team members to test and update our TFMS auto messaging to make it more useful.

CASE PROCESSING TIMES: The EO is maintaining the backlog at nearly zero daily. However, we still have self-service items to implement. Soon we will have the same result for Customer Service and Other cases that have been pending for a while.

REMINDERS:

- Voting in TICA elections and proposed rule changes In order for you to vote in each Fall's balloting for elections of TICA Officers, Regional Directors, Breed Committees, etc., and to vote on proposed rule changes, you must be a member as of April 1 AND renew your TICA membership during May 1 through June 30 to be eligible to vote in the upcoming Fall ballot. Put another way, if you join TICA on May 1 you are not eligible to vote in the Fall election because you were not a member as of April 1.
- ◆ Dr. Elsey sponsorships Don't forget to request corporate sponsorship from Dr. Elsey's for your show(s). The sponsorship form is available at tica.org. When you get to the main page, click on the search bar (upper left hand corner) and type in "Sponsorship Form". There you will find all the information you need to submit a request for sponsorship. Also remember, if you receive a TICA Dr Elsey sponsorship for your show, include the Dr Elsey logo on your website, show flyer, exhibitor catalog, marked catalog, and all promotional materials and submit a report after the show's completion.
- Change of Address Remember to notify the TICA Executive Office, TICA Trend Editor AND the Regional Director of changes of address, phone, and/or email.
- The 2022/2023 show season will be tabulated under Isolated Status Rules, as was done for the past three show seasons!
- ◆ Lifetime Achievement Award—If your cat has achieved a combination of 3 IW's/RW's, with at least one IW, your cat is eligible for a Lifetime Achievement Award! This award is NOT automatic. You need to apply for it: https://tica.org/resources/our-forms/file/54-lifetime-achievement-award. If your cat is achieving its third IW/RW win in the current show season, and you want your LA title to be on the awards, your claim form must be submitted to the EO by May 7 of that year. Note: If you apply after May 7, the LA title will not show up on your awards as of the past show season. You can apply for the title at any time even for cats that were shown years ago and the LA will be recognized in any future show season.
- ♦ Outstanding Sire/Outstanding Dam Female cats who have given birth to 5 kittens who have achieved the title of GRAND CHAMPION or GRAND CHAMPION ALTER or higher can apply for the title Outstanding Dam. Male cats who have sired 10 kittens who have achieved the title of GRAND CHAMPION or GRAND CHAMPION ALTER or higher can apply for the title Outstanding Sire. Do you have cats that qualify? The titles aren't automatic so you will need to use the appropriate form to claim your cat's titles:
