<u>Updates from the TICA Executive Office (EO):</u> With the implementation of TFMS about 1 year ago, we are finally back to a manageable level of service requests requiring staff processing. We appreciate your patience. Here's an update:

- 80% of the litter certificates and breeder slips are issued immediately (SBT/SBV). We are beta testing the automated lineage review of non-SBT/SBV litters.
- Extended pedigree research Average processing time is down to one week turn-around.
- Pedigrees requesting printed and mailed Average processing time is 1 to 1-1/2 weeks.
- 4) Transfer of ownership Average 1 day (or less).
- 5) Individual cat registrations Average 1 day (or less).
- 6) Customer Service Open Cases we're currently sitting with about 1,000 open cases. These are cases that need assistance by staff. We're down 1 person in the EO and have been dealing with staff out of the office for various reasons.

We continue to see growth in all areas of service ranging from number of registered cats, processing of 3-gen and 5-gen pedigrees, and litter registrations.

<u>Update on TOES purchase</u>: We are making good progress. The acquisition contract has been executed. Payments for the purchase will be spread over a 2-3 year period. When the Board approved this purchase, it was understood this would be a major project to integrate two separate systems. While the systems are being integrated, the user (the clubs and exhibitors) will not see any down-time. We will continue to use the TICA calendar (under the TOES system).

<u>Breeder Listings:</u> We are making significant progress in the functionality for breeder listings. We expect the 'newly updated' process to happen in the next few months.

Automation of Transfer of Ownership: In August, TICA rolled out automation for the Transfer of Ownership process. You will now be able to sign into your TFMS account, click on a cat you own, and add or remove a co-owner, TFMS will notify the co-owner(s) for authorization, once approved via the automated email, all you will then need to do is move the transaction to the Shopping Cart, pay the fee, and it's a completed transaction.

Each owner is notified via automated email of the proposed transfer and can either approve or deny the transaction. This ensures a cat is not transferred without the owner's approval.

The new Self-service transfer of ownership is virtually instantaneous after all owners approve the transfer and when payment is complete. And, even better ... Everything can be done online in TFMS account, no paper forms are needed.

<u>Breeder Assistance:</u> Did you know the Region can help breeders? This committee assists breeders who reside in the TICA NW Region, and who find themselves needing temporary (or more permanent) assistance.

This Committee helps with advice, food, physical assistance, and placement of cats, but only if requested. Assistance provided through this committee is 100% confidential.

Help and support is provided (only upon request) for reasons

## such as:

- Illness, temporary or permanent disability
- Death, without provision for the animals
- Temporary loss of home or housing
- Loss of employment
- Unforeseen change in personal family situation
- Temporary financial hardship
- Number of cats beyond care capacity
- New legislation in the area which affects the number of cats allowed in a household
- Acts of nature
- Need for temporary food, litter and/or vet card (if funding can be secured).

If you find yourself in need of help, contact the Regional Director. You will be put in contact with someone in your local area that can help you!

EXERCISE YOUR RIGHT TO VOTE! We typically only get 20-25% of those eligible to vote who actually take the time to do so.

## **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- When making any payment, be sure to identify what the payment is for and who it is from.
- Sorry, the region cannot accept E-transfer payments because the Region's bank account is in the United States. E-transfers only work from one Canadian bank account to another.

Did you remember to pay your entry fees for a show? Ever have that moment when you weren't sure if you paid your entry fees for a show and can't find your confirmation? If the show uses TOES for entries, there is no need to contact the entry clerk. Just log in to TOES and click on the show in the show calendar. Scroll to the bottom of the show details. You will see the cats you've entered in the show. Below that you will see the space you requested along with the total amount owed, paid and due! Important notes:

- You won't see any information on your cats, space, etc. if you aren't logged in!
- If you only have placeholders the financial data will not show. You need to have at least one cat's information entered for the financial summary to display.

#### **REMINDERS:**

Voting in TICA elections and proposed rule changes — In order for you to vote in each Fall's balloting for elections of TICA Officers, Regional Directors, Breed Committees, etc., and to vote on proposed rule changes, you must be a member as of April 1 AND renew your TICA membership during May 1 through June 30 to be eligible to vote in the upcoming Fall ballot. Put another way, if you join TICA on May 1 you are not eligible to vote in the Fall election because you were not a member as of April 1.



Dr. Elsey sponsorships — Don't forget to request corporate sponsorship from Dr. Elsey's for your show(s). The sponsorship form is available at tica.org. When you get to the main page, click on the search bar (upper left hand corner) and type in "Sponsorship

Form". There you will find all the information you need to submit a request for sponsorship. Also remember, if you receive a TICA Dr Elsey sponsorship for your show, include the Dr Elsey logo on your website, show flyer, exhibitor catalog, marked catalog, and all promotional materials and submit a report after the show's completion. Thank you for your sup-

- Change of Address Remember to notify the TICA Executive Office, TICA Trend Editor AND the Regional Director of changes of address, phone, and/or email.
- The 2022/2023 show season will be tabulated under Isolated Status Rules, as was done for the past three show seasons!
- Lifetime Achievement Award—If your cat has achieved a combination of 3 IW's/RW's, with at least one IW, your cat is eligible for a Lifetime Achievement Award! This award is NOT automatic. You need to apply for it: https://tica.org/ resources/our-forms/file/54-lifetime-achievement-award. If your cat is achieving its third IW/RW win in the current show season, and you want your LA title to be on the awards, your claim form must be submitted to the EO by May 7 of that year. Note: If you apply after May 7, the LA title will not show up on your awards as of the past show season. You can apply for the title at any time - even for cats that were shown years ago - and the LA will be recognized in any future show
- Outstanding Sire/Outstanding Dam Female cats who have given birth to 5 kittens who have achieved the title of GRAND CHAMPION or GRAND CHAMPION ALTER or higher can apply for the title Outstanding Dam. Male cats who have sired 10 kittens who have achieved the title of GRAND CHAMPION or GRAND CHAMPION ALTER or higher can apply for the title Outstanding Sire. Do you have cats that qualify? The titles aren't automatic so you will need to use the appropriate form to claim your cat's titles:
